

Keep your Glass Looking its Best

01 | CLEANING STEPS.

Dry Wipe: Use a clean microfiber cloth to remove dust and debris first.

Apply Cleaner: Use one of the following:

- + **Standard Areas (Single-Glazed Only):** Mild soap + water, 50/50 vinegar-water, or low-VOC glass cleaner (e.g., Windex, CRL #1973). Use with caution on double-glazed glass.
- + **Sensitive Areas (All Glass Types):** Use foaming glass cleaner, wipes, alcohol-free mists (applied to cloth), or dry microfiber. Safe for use near channels, gaskets, or rails.

Wipe and Dry: Clean with a soft cloth, then dry immediately using a clean microfiber or squeegee. Avoid letting liquid collect in channels.

Inspect: Check from multiple angles to ensure a streak-free finish.

02 | BEST PRACTICES.

- + Clean in shade, not direct sunlight.
- + Keep humidity between 40–55%.
- + Spray onto cloth, not directly near gaskets or channels.

03 | AVOID USING.

- + Harsh solvents (acetone, MEK)
- + Abrasive pads or powders
- + Razor blades or metal tools
- + Ammonia or bleach on coated frames

04 | CLEANING FREQUENCY.

- + Post-Install: Within 3 days
- + Routine: Weekly or bi-weekly
- + Deep Clean: Every 3–6 months
